These changes are important and a Public Procurement Professional must be aware of the same with deeper understanding. Most of these are planned to be covered in the seminar.

This seminar will be beneficial for all critical stakeholders. It will help develop knowledge and ability for efficient procurement with clear understanding and complying with the latest provisions in General Financial Rules (GFR), Procurement Manuals and also understand and effectively use latest developments on GeM. For faster learning, it is important to interact, share and understand difficulties faced and solutions discovered in procurement related issues by others similarly placed officials. This seminar will provide ample opportunity for the same. The participant will also understand the mission and objectives of Govt. of India to move forward towards development of MSME sector, domestic manufacturing and ease of doing business in government with relevant GFR & GeM updates. The subject will help improve the delivery with improved system productivity & compliance. Other details are given in the enclosed Brochure.
